

RESOLUTION NO. 1564

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF WINSLOW
REQUESTING THAT AMENDMENTS TO THE
SUPERVISORIAL DISTRICT BOUNDARIES OF
NAVAJO COUNTY NOT DISENFRANCHISE THE
CITIZENS OF WINSLOW AND SURROUNDING
AREAS**

WHEREAS the 2010 census has been completed, and as a result, the boundaries for the supervisorial districts are required to change to reflect the increased population in some areas of the County, and;

WHEREAS the election of supervisors is critical to the representation of the City of Winslow and the surrounding residents before the Navajo County Board of Supervisors, and;


WHEREAS the participation of the Navajo County population in and around the City of Winslow is critical to keep the Navajo County Board of Supervisors advised of issues which must be dealt with on behalf of the residents in and near the City of Winslow.

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Winslow, Arizona, hereby advises and proclaims to the Navajo County Board of Supervisors and the Redistricting Committee that the City of Winslow and the surrounding residents must be included in the same supervisorial district to comply with federal law, and to avoid disenfranchising the electorate residing in and near the City of Winslow.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City requests that those involved in drawing the supervisorial boundaries recognize the requirement not to disenfranchise large blocks of voters who would ordinarily vote the same, not to disenfranchise large minority votes, and not to disenfranchise the residents of one geographical area which would normally vote as a


block, all in accordance with federal law, and in accordance with the needs and best interests of the citizens residing in and near the City of Winslow.


